Bovilis MH + IBR

It is a requirement of the Beef Spectacular Feedback Trial to administer one vaccination of Bovilis MH + IBR by August 1. The Bovilis MH + IBR will be FREE again and a Coopers Animal Health representative will be in touch with you as soon as you enter to discuss delivery. To be eligible for the FREE Bovilis MH + IBR you must enter prior to July 17, otherwise it is up to you to supply your own.

FREE Freight

Shanahans Livestock Transport will provide FREE Freight from central saleyard points across NSW and Victoria and up to QLD border if required and routes to be devised by trial coordinator. The routes will be organised once entries are in on July 17. To be eligible for the FREE freight you must enter your teams by July 17.

Note: You will need to deliver your cattle to the appropriate saleyard by 4pm on Tuesday August 24, for the Shanahans trucks to pick them up and transport overnight to reduce time off feed.

NVD's – A National Vendor Declaration must accompany your cattle with the Shanahans truck to Tey's Jindalee Feedlot. The NVD must be consigned to Tey's Australia Jindalee Feedlot, Stockinbingal, NSW.

Note: Even though you are dropping your cattle at saleyards and Shanahans are transporting you need to consign to Teys Australia Jindalee Feedlot, Stockinbingal NSW.

Filling in entry forms

Entry forms must be filled in for each available space on form. Eg, Month of Birth needs to be estimated or a range – June to Aug 2012

Cattle Nomination forms do not need to be sent with entry – you can send nomination for specific cattle by August 1, but no later. This nomination form must have correct NLIS or RFID numbers for each animal and the Bovilis MH + IBR Bottle ID code on the Nomination form. Points will be deducted if not done.

Cattle Entry

Cattle will be entered on Wednesday August 24 (Remember cattle will be trucked the night before).

Each exhibitor will be sent a management Tag with the numbers 1-5 and a team number on them. This is to allow ease of sorting as they come off trucks at the feedlot. If the Tags that we send out are not used points will be deducted accordingly. These Tags need to be married up with the cattle nomination NLIS or RFID you nominate

Field Day

A mid-term field day will be held for you to view your cattle after 80 days on feed at Teys Australia's Jindalee Feedlot, with speakers from Australia's leading feedlot and Agricultural businesses.

Presentation Night

A presentation dinner will be held End of January, 2022 in Wagga Wagga, where winners will be announced, awards presented and you will receive a 50+ page bound document with all the feedback comparisons of cattle in the trial from each exhibitor.
