A broken femur in the three places, a compact fractured arm and a shattered elbow in 2004 left him wheelchair bound for four months. It took a year to recover from the physical injuries and the mental fear from that tumble.

Favourite stunt - At the moment, the ruler back-flip.

Career highlight - Getting paid to ride my bike.

Current ambition - I'm currently sitting in first position in the standings of the Under Ground Tour 2012, with two rounds to go. The plan is to bring the title home.

He never imagined he would one day be chosen to represent his country in England, but perseverance made it possible. There was a broken leg at 16 that left him in plaster for two months, but the tumble that hurt the most was the one that kept him off work for two months. He had a broken shoulder, five cracked ribs and a collapsed lung.
