In 2013 former Kinross Wolaroi School student Jade Ryan became the first member of her family to finish Year 12 and now the talented all-rounder is about to realise another dream: studying medicine at university.

The Cowra girl and former KWS boarder has been accepted into the Bachelor of Medicine course at the University of Newcastle and will begin her studies this year.

She says two years at KWS gave her the confidence to take this next major step in her life.

"I started boarding at KWS in 2012, at the start of Year 11," Jade said.

"That's also when I started thinking about studying medicine.

"I gained so much from Kinross. The teachers were outstanding and they really helped me to get through the two years.

"Being a boarder meant I made really close friends with the other students as well.

"It just gave me more opportunities than I could ever imagine."

With help from her very supportive mum Sandie, Jade applied to study through the university's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander program.

"The uni rang during the HSC and asked me to come down in December for a week-long, pre-entry program," Jade said.

"During the course I met the tutors who will be teaching us and they were really cool.

"Now I'm looking forward to just doing the actual courses with them, but I'm also looking forward to living in the city."

Sandie is thrilled that her daughter is heading off to university and believes Jade's success is a

combination of the opportunities and support provided by KWS and her daughter's own drive.

"Jade is very focused and I knew when she got the opportunity to come to Kinross she would really take advantage of it, but I didn't grasp how far she would come," Sandie said.

"Everything at Kinross was positive, including the teachers just letting her know she could do anything. Having that support was huge."

Jade made every post a winner at the school, working hard in class to achieve an ATAR of 82.35 and securing places in the firsts football and basketball teams, and representing KWS at NSW CIS athletics.

Her new goals are a little less clear, but at this stage she's leaning towards specialising in surgery or paediatrics, and she plans to return to the country to practise.
