Do I have a choice of doctor?
Yes - as a private health fund insured or self-funded patient you have the option to choose your treating doctor.

Can I transfer to Calvary from another hospital?
YES – please let your doctor or the hospital staff know that you would like to be transferred to Calvary.

What do I do if I am told Calvary is full and doesn't have a bed for me?
Please talk to your doctor, or you can call our Booking Office or After Hours Co-ordinator on 6925 3055 to check on bed availability.

Can I have my special foods?
YES – all dietary requirements can be accommodated.

Can I have a private room?
YES – you can have a private room, however availability is dependent on the time you are admitted to Calvary.

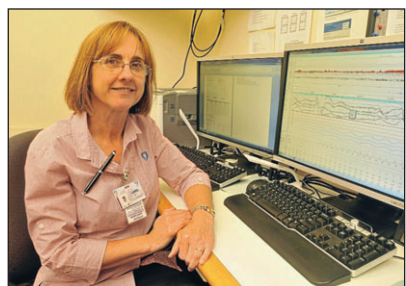
If I pay into a Private Health Fund does that automatically cover me for ALL procedures at Calvary?

Can I come to Calvary if I do not have private health insurance?
YES - self funded patients can come to Calvary, please contact our Patient Services on 6923 2313 for a cost estimate.

How do I get help when I go home?
Calvary's Discharge Planner will discuss with you any assistance you require when you go home.
