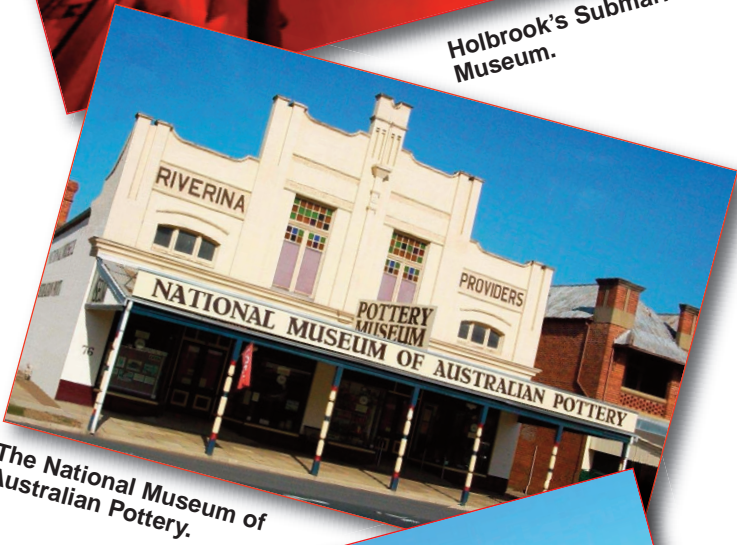

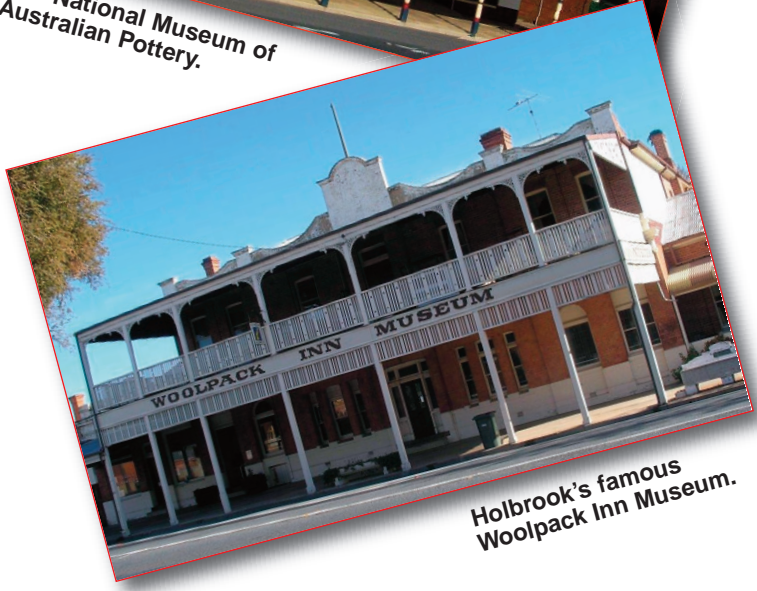

THE Happening in Holbrook Festival will be held over weekend of 19-20 October with a huge variety of events.

Saturday commences from 9am with a Collectors Fair and helicopter joy flights over Holbrook and at 10am the Market and Craft Stalls open and the Show n Shine begins along with jumping castles, miniature train rides and a Gala Art Show and Kids Photographic Competition.

A highlight of the Festival will be the grand street parade kicking off from 2pm.

Historic trucks, veteran and vintage cars and flexible clippers (restored Pioneer Coaches), ultra light aeroplanes, colourful local floats, marching bands and military vehicles and animals will all be participating in the parade plus so much more.

And don't miss the ultra lights flypast during the parade.

All day bands and entertainers will be playing in different locations in Holbrook culminating in a huge live concert in Ten Mile Creek Gardens from 4-6pm.

The Prairie Oysters and Korey Livy, Riverina Concert Band and Albury Wodonga Pipes and Drums are just some of the entertainers along with buskers.

Evening entertainment will be available in the local pubs and RSL Club.

On Sunday the Woolpack Inn Museum will hold an Open Day from 9.30am, which will include a barbecue and many displays including Ladies Handicrafts from yesteryear and Henty Antique Farm Machinery Club will display their engines.

The Submarine Museum, Woolpack Inn Museum and National Museum of Australian Pottery will be open all weekend.

Warren Thompson, Chair of the Festival committee and proprietor of the Submarine Cafe, is supported by an energetic committee and enthusiastic Holbrook community.

"We are very excited about the line up of events over the weekend, there is something for all the family and many of the events are free," he said.

Mayor of Greater Hume Shire Council and Holbrook resident, Heather Wilton, said the Holbrook community have put in many hours of preparation to ensure visitors to Holbrook enjoy a truly spectacular weekend.

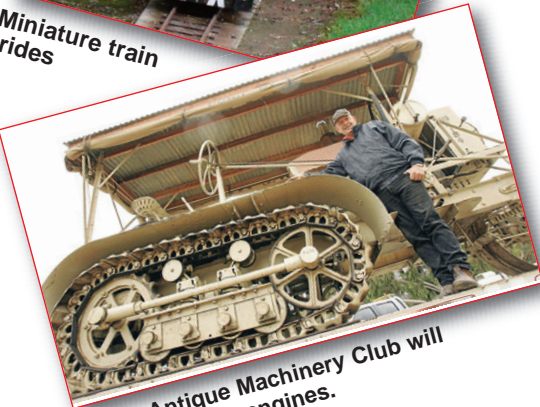

Saturday October 19:

■ **9am-3pm:** Collectors Fair at the Holbrook Shire Hall at the corner of Young and Albury streets. Swap/sell tables

■ **9.20am-6pm:** Helifly of Albury will be providing Joy flights over Holbrook and the new Hume Highway bypass from the corner of Young St and Railway parade.

■ **10am:** More than 30 interesting market and craft stalls will be open for business in the submarine park until sunset

■ **10am-1pm:** Show and Shine. Massive event with hundreds of Vintage and Veteran vehicles and more at the Circus Flats, corner of Fleet and Raymond streets, near the submarine.

■ **10am-2pm:** Free supervised children's jumping castles will be behind St Patrick's School in Albury St and ice cream and slushies will be available.

■ **11am-2pm:** Entertainment in the submarine precinct

■ **Noon-1pm:** Public viewing of all the street parade entries in the marshalling area North of the submarine in Fleet, Spring, Bond and Raymond streets. Public Voting for best floats in category. Voting booths will be in the park area next to the submarine, in front of the Submarine Café and in front of the Uniting Church in Albury Street.

■ **1.45am:** Official launch of the Happening in Holbrook Festival-Greater Hume Shire Mayor Cr Heather Wilton and special guests.

■ **11.45am-12.45pm:** Free concert by Riverina Concert band adjacent to the submarine in park area in front of the Submarine Café.

■ **1.15-1.45pm:** Free concert adjacent to the submarine in the submarine park featuring The Prairie Oysters.

■ **2-3.30pm:** Massive street parade with hundreds of

entries. Commences at submarine precinct in Albury St and proceeds South in Albury St to Young St and disperse. The parade will include marching bands, historic trucks, Flxible Clippers (restored pioneer coaches), Veteran and Vintage vehicles, motor bikes, ultra-light aeroplanes, marching groups, colourful local floats, animals, military vehicles, hybrid tractors, b-triple truck and more.

■ **2-3.30pm:** Fly-past of ultra-light aeroplanes during the parade.

■ **3-6pm:** Jumping castles in 10 Mile Creek Gardens (south side) near the rotunda.

■ **4-6pm:** Massive free concert in lower 10 Mile Creek Gardens featuring The Prairie Oysters and Corey Livy.

■ **4pm:** Lions Club barbecue in 10 Mile Creek gardens.

■ **4pm:** Free concert by Albury-Wodonga Pipes and Drums in parkland across the 10 Mile Creek Bridge next to Grimwood's historic store. Two sessions at 4pm and 5pm.

All day:

■ National Australian Pottery Museum, Albury St; Woolpack Inn Museum, Albury St; Submarine Museum in the submarine precinct and the UPA Hostel in Bowler St.

■ Miniature train rides around 10 Mile Creek park.

■ Gala Art Show and Kids Photographic Competition at St Mary McKillop Hall.

Sunday October 20:

■ The Woolpack Inn Museum's Open Day from 9.30am will include a barbecue and displays including Ladies Handicrafts from yesteryear and Henty Antique Machinery Club will display their engines.

■ The Submarine Museum and National Museum of Australian Pottery will also be open all weekend.

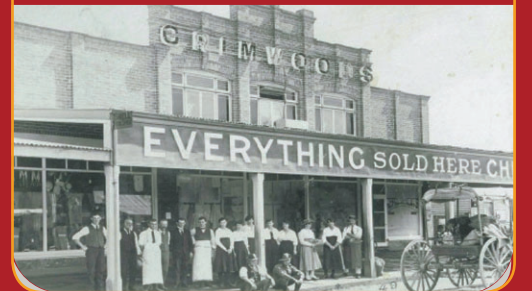

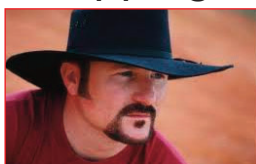
