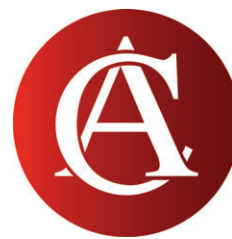

"Daniel has been able to combine his work requirements at the same time as completing his CA study and has done an excellent job in both areas," Mr Pryor said.

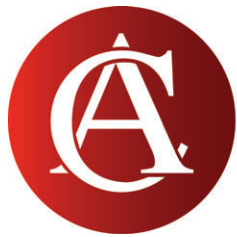
"We at Twomeys believe very strongly in developing and supporting young undergraduates throughout their tertiary education and also through their further professional CA qualifications",
