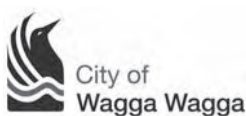

Shirazz

Shirazz is a six-piece Melbourne trad jazz and dixieland band, specialising in classic hot jazz of the 20s and 30s, and has a reputation as one of Victoria's most exciting jazz bands.

Shirazz plays classic trad jazz as it is meant to be played. With hot solos, driving rhythms and tight arrangements, a set from Shirazz is a step back in time, to a jumping New Orleans dance hall where fast, hot tunes intersect with swinging standards and laid-back Louisiana street beats. With the odd original tune and some re-imagined pop classics, Shirazz should be enjoyed irresponsibly, and in excess.

Shirazz exploded onto the jazz festival circuit with roof-raising performances at the Echuca and Moe Jazz Festivals in early 2010. Since then, the band has become highly regarded on the Victorian festival circuit and is now also in demand at interstate festivals. Shirazz travels regularly across the state and across the country, including many trips to New South Wales and Queensland.

Closer to home, Shirazz plays regularly across Melbourne, and had the honour of supporting James Morrison at Red Bennies for Stonnington Jazz 2012. They have released three albums, the second of which was nominated for "Best Australian Traditional Jazz Album" at the Jazz Bell Awards.



The Janet Seidel Trio

Based in Sydney, Australia, vocalist / pianist Janet Seidel currently enjoys a rare and enviable international reputation with 17 CDs released in Australia and also available in several other countries. In the Penguin Guide to Jazz on CD 2006 (UK) she is described as "Australia's first lady of jazz singing".



Psycho Zydeco

Sydney based Psycho Zydeco have established themselves as the country's premier roots act specialising in the high-energy, uplifting style of music known as zydeco, a style born in the swamplands and bayou area of Louisiana's Deep South. The band's earthy blend of traditional Cajun, blues, and swamp music produces a heady mix of their brand of Zydeco. Driving washboard, drums, guitar, saxophone, organ, piano and the odd triangle combine with some amazing accordion playing to create music that will make you move.
