Finals fever

THE Glen Innes Magpies' reserve grade side is the only side alive in Group 19 grand final chase after a disappointing preliminary finals day for the club at Mead Park on Sunday.

Glen Innes had all four sides in action on Sunday vying for grand final spots, but reserve grade were the only side to advance after a magnificent 32-20 win over the Inverell Hawks.

The Hawks scored first, but the Magpies hit back through Ace Holliss who regathered his own grubber and converted sensational from the sideline.

Magpie junior Brayden Gallagher stepped up to reserve

grade to fill in on the wing and had another fantastic game.

He crossed next when he was on the end of a sensational Nick Lehman cut out ball and Holliss converted from out wide again to give the Magpies a 12-6 lead.

Glen got one more try before half time and another just after to lead 22-6.

The Hawks got one back, but two more Magpie tries and a penalty goal to Holliss sealed a memorable win.

It was a tremendous all-round effort from the entire squad, with skipper Will Newberry not able to pick a standout player.

"Everyone stepped up and

played well," he said.

The day started off in heart-breaking fashion for the Magpies with the ladies league-tag going down 14-10 in golden point to the Ashford Roosters.

Shannan Merchant sent the game to extra time with a penalty goal from 30 metres out on full time.

In the second period of extra time the Roosters crossed in the corner to leave the Magpies ladies devastated.

The Magpies juniors were bundled out after going down to the Goondiwindi Boars 36-30.

Glen Innes had their chances to win the match, but failed to

execute against a well drilled Boars side.

The Magpies first grade failed to reach the grand final for the second straight year after falling to the Inverell Hawks 26-18.

Scores were locked at 16-all at half time and the Magpies actually led 18-16 with 12 minutes to go, but two late Hawks tries snatched victory.

The Magpie reserves will take on the Moree Boomerangs in Sunday's grand final at Moree's Burt Javonovic Oval at around 1pm.
