Mr Taylor said that the Show was a credit to the organising committee and remarked that the Crookwell Show continued on in the tradition of genuine rural shows. Mr Taylor said:

"The Show, is probably the best annual show case of Crookwell and the entire community. It is always great to see that there is still so much interest in the agricultural side of things at Crookwell, and heartening to see that people are still participating in competitions and sharing their crafts and hobbies and share them with the broader community.

"I spent a fair bit of my time in my youth participating in horse events at local shows and gymkhanas. Although my brothers and I always turned up in stock saddles, not show saddles. I won a few barrel races in my time, but I never won a dressage event!"

Mr Taylor said that from is point of view, the Crookwell Show was one of the best shows across the region and the sprawling federal electorate of Hume which he is seeking to represent. The seat of Hume spans from just outside Camden in the North East, down to the ACT border and out to Grenfell and Cowra in the West.
