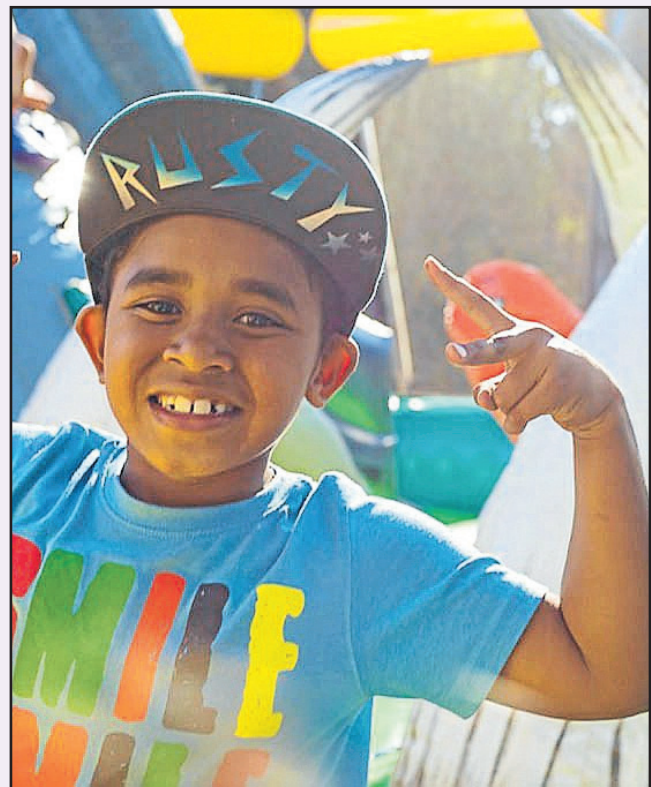

Chill out and save

SUMMER can be a time of extreme weather events, but that doesn't mean you need to go to extremes to keep cool and save on

electricity costs.

ActewAGL marketing director Paul Walshe says households can expect to use more energy in summer whether

it's through home cooling, or running an additional fridge, but we can take measures to avoid the extremes.

"For example make sure you set your air-conditioning no lower than 24 degrees. Every degree you lower it can add 10 per cent to your electricity bill," Mr Walshe said.

Some other energy saving tips include:

- If you are going on holidays, switch off your hot water system and other major appliances.

- Insulated homes retain cool air and minimise heat transferring from the outside air.

- Fans can be a cheap, low-energy way of moving cool air around the home. The stream of air blowing over someone in a room can reduce the temperature of the air around them by 2 to 3 degrees.

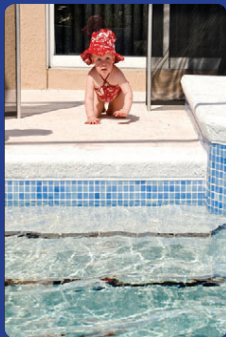
- If using airconditioning, set fans to high speeds for greatest efficiency.

- Shade windows with awnings or curtains. Blocking the sun before it strikes your glass could save you up to \$100 per year in cooling costs.
