**Norfolk Island offers a beautiful, mild climate, officially classified as subtropical. Whatever time of year you visit the majestic landscape travellers are never disappointed.**

## The place to be whatever the weather

THE weather on Norfolk Island is steady all year round. This beautiful, mild climate usually sits between 10 to 26 degrees. Officially classified as a marine subtropical climate, Norfolk Island gets over 1300 millimetres of rain every year. The majority of this rain falls in the months from April to August although any month can be a "wet one". The summer months are warm and long while the winter months from June to August are much wetter than the rest of the year but still with a mild climate.

Humidity is usually high, ranging from 74 to 79 per cent at 9am and 71 to 74 per cent at 3pm. Thunder storms most often occur during winter and spring with roughly 12 storms each year. Norfolk Island weather also includes on average one hailstorm each year too. Cyclones rarely hit the island but sometimes influence weather conditions early in the year.

Norfolk Island is situated approximately 1000 kilometres east of the Australian coast, 1670 kilometres east north east of Sydney, 1065

kilometres north north west of Auckland and 772 kilometres south east of Noumea.

Travelling to Norfolk Island by air direct to the island from Sydney or Brisbane takes approximately two and a half hours, alternatively a journey takes just one and a half hours from Auckland or two and a half hours from Christchurch.

The trip from Melbourne or Adelaide requires a change of planes in Sydney, so it normally takes about four hours. From Perth, it's somewhat longer and some travellers like to take a stopover in Sydney.

Remember that Norfolk is not a territory of Australia, but simply a territory under its control, so flights leave from the international terminal and a passport is required.

By sea, there are infrequent cruise ships and sailing vessels travelling to Norfolk Island. A freight shipping line leaves from New Zealand and Australia and takes between two and five days to get to Norfolk.
