INFORMATION REGARDING

On this date, AE 'made a formal statement and complaint that during 1953-4, while she was a student at St Brigid's School at Raymond Terrace, she was sexually assaulted by Father Denis McALINDEN on a number of occasions.

In that statement, she outlines that she told her mother and father about the sexual assaults and her parents bought it to the attention of the Bishop: AE states that with her parents, she went to the Bishop's house but sat in the car while her parents met with the Bishop.

AE believes NP came to the AE As a result of that meeting, house and spoke to the family about the contents of the letter.

Police request that if there could be any record of this letter allegedly sent to the AE family regarding this incident, could police have a copy of that letter. Both the parents of AE are now deceased and there was no copy of the letter found in their possessions.
