Two victims have indicated their intention to pursue the matters at court whilst the third wishes only to give evidence. During investigations Police became aware that Priest POI 3 was committing similar offences against young boys at the same time POI 2 in a neighbouring parish. POI 3 has been convicted of sexual assaults against more than 30 young boys which occurred in overlapping periods as those connected with POI 2. Many of the alleged victims of both priests were altar boys at the times of the offences. POI 3 has been convicted & is serving a substantive gaol sentence. POI2 is awaiting trial on 22/11/04. Throughout the investigation of POI 2 members of the local clergey impeded police investigations. The local Bishop & other priests advised POI 2 of information not availble to him at that time.
