He said that at least one parent and three teachers had given him information in regard to a second victim (~~the~~ insinuated maybe more). He said the teacher's had told him they had approached various people in the CSO-Diocesan Organisation including principals and at least one had approached the Bishop.

He said the teacher's did not have evidence of actual incidents but had concerns about Fr Fletcher's behaviour towards children/students, had brought this to the attention of various people in "your education system".

He said he was about to apply for a search warrant to enable him to get all the information he held on Fr Fletcher and just wanted to let us know before he "arrived on the doorstep" so we could gather that information for him. He said this information would go back 20 years - early 1980's to late 1990's - 2nd victim 1983-1984. I asked ~~him~~ ^{to} him if he could first send me a fax detailing his position & request for the required information and I asked him whether ~~he~~ I needed to inform the Chancery. He said that he had put a call in to the Chancery and was awaiting a reply. He said there would be a separate search warrant for CSO/our premises. I told him that I would inform the Director of this.

He said the warrant would be issued within the next week.
