

Spoke to **AH** in response to a very angry/distressed message he left on the PSO answering machine.

His primary issue seems to be the Bishop: the Bishop needs to "tell the truth"; the Bishop rang him after the court case and read out a prepared statement of regret then hung up – "that's not good enough"; the Bishop has threatened **AH**'s father (re his employment); the police are disgusted with the Bishop's (perceived) lack of appropriate response to **AH** and the other victims; the Bishop hasn't spoken to **AH**'s family, especially his wife who wants an apology for herself.

**AH** feels the PSO needs to tell the Bishop that he (the Bishop) has to "come out and tell the truth".

It is clear that the criminal justice system hasn't delivered the sense of closure that **AH** seems to be looking for. In particular, he feels his story – and the impact on him and his family - hasn't been heard

I spoke a bit about TH and how it might be able to deliver some of the outcomes **AH** seems to be seeking and offered to send him the TH book which he accepted.
