C Views of Tathra Wharf, transportation, views to sacred sites of Mumbulla Mountain and Gulaga, local impetus to stop development to the north in 1970s, rare kelp, manta rays, fish life, sharks, whales etc

D Wharf activities, diving, Daniel Gowing, Tathra Wharf Museum, National Trust Building.....

Other matters:

- 6 Install second pathway around the edge of the cliff above Shelley Beach linking existing walk path from Cliff Place to the beach with Tathra hotel carpark Seating Areas - associated with Viewing Platforms
- 7 Picnic Area and Provision of a roofed shelter
- 8 Reinstate stairs to Swimming Rock Pool
- 9 Construct stairs from Lions Memorial Garden look out to Interpretive site B
- 10 Improve and maintain existing walking track
 11 Existing Walk to Kianniny along coastline

 and also signs at existing walking track to the south at Pig and
 Whistle Lookout.
