1990 SYNOD RESOLUTIONS

- 90.01 PRESIDENTIAL CHARGE
 "That the Bishop be congratulated and thanked for his Charge to Synod and that copies be printed for distribution among Synod members throughout the Diocese."
- 90.02 1991 BUDGET AND PARISH CONTRIBUTIONS
 "That the Diocesan Budget estimates and Parish Contributions proposed for 1991 and tabled before this Synod on pages 306-334 of the business paper be approved."
- 90.03 1991 MISSIONARY TARGETS
 "That the proposed Missionary Targets for 1991 as tabled before this Synod on pages 335-337 of the business paper be approved."
- 90.04 U.S.S.R. ARMS REDUCTION, RECOGNITION OF THE SOVEREIGN RICHTS WITHIN THE EASTERN BLOCK
 "That this Synod recognises the great steps taken by the U.S.S.R. towards arms reduction, recognition of the sovereign rights of nations within the Eastern Block, and the advances towards true democracy within the Soviet political system.

Synod further acknowledges the efforts of the Soviet President, Mikhail Gorbachev, in providing the leadership so necessary in this process and congratulates him on this giant step towards reducing world tension and thereby advancing the cause of world peace.

This resolution is to be sent to the Minister for Foreign Affairs and the Soviet Ambassador."

- 90.05 1991 BUDGET
 "That this Synod authorise the Diocesan Council to review the proposed budget for 1991 with a view to reducing expenditure in some specific areas and re-directing funding for:
 - 1) a hospital chaplain on the Central Coast
 - 2) a specific chaplain (part-time) to the sufferers of A.I.D.S.

However, if this is not achievable the Diocesan Council includes the chaplaincies in the 1992 budget."

90.06 ECOLOGICALLY SOUND USE OF THE LAND "That this Synod recognises the need for the Church to play a leading role in shaping the values and behaviour of people in the way we use the land and natural resources.

And that a working committee be set up by the Bishop and Diocesan Council to report to the next session of this Synod on ways and means of encouraging sustainable and ecologically sound use of the land and programmed reduction of all forms of pollution to air, land and water."

90.07 CHILDREN'S COURTS
"That this Synod, as a matter of urgency, requests the Bishop to consult with appropriate persons to ascertain effective ways of ministering to those children's courts in the diocese not presently being covered, and that whatever action he can take immediately with the resources available he do so and that possible sources of funding in this area be explored and the matter be made a priority in the 1992 Diocesan Budget."
