Fraud operation charges local man

A 46-year-old Goulburn businessman has spent Easter in jail after being charged as part of a fraud investigation. Darren Brian Parker, of Exeter, was arrested last Tuesday afternoon and charged with nine counts of knowingly deal in the proceeds of crime with intent to conceal and use a telecommunication device to threaten. Mr Parker owns the Complete Photographics business in

Clifford St, Goulburn. He appeared in Goulburn Local Court late Wednesday and was refused bail. His co-accused, 28-year-old Kirkam St, Moss Vale woman, Natalie Brown, described in court as "his mistress," was also charged with knowingly deal in the proceeds of crime with intent to conceal and larceny as a clerk or servant. She was also refused bail in an earlier hearing.

Neither entered a plea and their cases were adjourned until May 16. Police are alleging "large scale fraud" involving more than \$200,000 from two related Bowral companies where Ms Kirkham was employed as a clerk.
