Eight out of 18, good enough?

LESS than half of Goulburn Mulwaree Council's candidates took part in The Goulburn Group's (TGG) environmental survey, which probed their views on a range of issues including how to best address climate change locally.

Mayor Geoff Kettle, deputy mayor Bob Kirk, Neil Penning and Andrew Banfield were the only sitting councillors to respond along with hopefuls Sam Rowland, Jason Shepherd, Richard Orchard and Laszlo Strasser. While a number of TGG members

were reportedly disappointed with the "poor turn-out", president Urs Walterlin didn't share their view and told the *Post* that he was quite happy with the level of response.

"It's a complicated issue. Climate change is not easy to understand. It can be overwhelming, even for climate scientists who have spent their lives researching it. But, that doesn't mean we should put our heads in the sand because it is a difficult issue. We should be taking up the challenge," he said.
