Nationals, Libs in Hume 'truce'

Coalition agreement infuriates Hodgkinson

MEMBER for Burrinjuck Katrina Hodgkinson has lambasted her own party over its decision not to contest the seat of Hume at the next federal election.

Widely tipped to be the

Nationals' candidate had they decided to run, Ms Hodgkinson said not opposing the Liberal Party was the wrong call.

"This week's decision by the small number of individuals that constitute the central executive of The Nationals to not stand a candidate in Hume will be deeply

disappointing for local branch members in this region," she said.

"We have a very strong branch membership throughout and surrounding the Hume electorate, many of whom have been ready and willing since 1998 to work like Trojans to restore the seat to its former National Party status, and

those members are going to be bitterly disappointed by this decision.

"More people than I can remember have expressed their firm view to me that The Nationals must recontest Hume when the sitting member retired, and many have also expressed their willing-

ness to stand for pre-selection, or a passion for working on the campaign.

"I strongly believe they should have been afforded that opportunity, and the decision made by central executive is wrong."
