# New bridge not too far

**A**FTER years of Council and community lobbying, the state government has finally committed to replacing Oallen Ford Bridge. A spokesperson for Roads Minister Duncan Gay told the *Post* that correspondence had taken place between local MPs and \$2.2million had been allocated toward the project. "The crossing of the Shoalhaven River is an important part of the freight corridor between Nowra to the inland areas of Barton and

Monaro," the spokesperson said. "The current bridge restricts the efficiency of the freight corridor as it is not approved for use by higher mass limit vehicles. "The upgrade of the Nerriga to Goulburn Road Freight Corridor will see the replacement of the current bridge over the Shoalhaven River at Oallen Ford to accommodate higher mass limit vehicles. "The NSW Government will allocate a grant of \$2.2m over two years towards the completion of these projects. The grant will be allocated in the 2013-14 and 2014-15 financial years."
