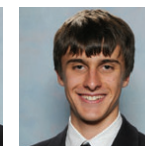

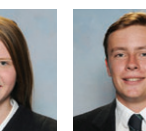

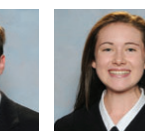

## OTHER NOTABLE ACHIEVEMENTS

### OUTSTANDING RESULTS

- Kinross Wolaroi School students received 94 Band 6 results, and a total of 383 Band 5 & 6 results (including Extension subject E3 & E4 results) with these results spread widely across all subject areas. This amounts to a huge 52.5% of all grades achieved by the students being Band 5 or 6.
- 46 different students have achieved one or more Band 6 results for a score over 90% in a subject.
- 2 students gained the privilege of being mentioned on the Premier's All-rounders' list - with Band 6 results in 10 or more units - we congratulate Dux of KWS Annabelle Carter and Rebekah Kwa on this honour.
- Hospitality student, Gemma Plunkett, finished in 9th place.
- Congratulations to Industrial Technology students Sam Pratten, James Coles and Jackson Ryan who had their major works selected for possible inclusion in the 'In Tech' display for Industrial Technology.
- Congratulations to Rebekah Kwa, Olivia Fisher and Annabelle Carter who have been selected for possible inclusion in 'Encore' for their Music major work.
- Congratulations to Shelby Archer, who has had her Visual Arts major work selected for possible inclusion in 'ArtExpress'.
- Our Year 11 Mathematics students who have been accelerated to sit HSC exams in 2013 also achieved wonderful Band 6 results - with Yr 11 Dux Olivia Brooks achieving Band 6 in both Mathematics and Extension Mathematics, whilst Annabel Biddulph, Nicole Pickford, Chengyi (Eric) Han, and Michelle Luk achieved a Band 6 result in Mathematics.
