Soak up the scenery at Hedberg Hill

PETER and Lee Hedberg began their Orange vineyard in 1998 after many years helping others to establish the Orange Wine Region. Peter has a long history in viticulture and was a founding member of the Orange Region Vignerons' Association.

A visit to Hedberg Hill showcases a lovely vineyard, stunning views to Mt Canobolas and a welcoming cellar door. Peter provides visitors with an interesting overview of the unique features of the Orange Region landscape.

He is the principle author of the booklet Orange Region Terroir, written in 2010.

Hedberg Hill presents four white varieties: Riesling, Sauvignon Blanc, Chardonnay and Viognier and three red varieties: Tempranillo, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon.

The hilltop vineyard is just three kilometres from Orange, on The Escort Way, and is open every weekend from 10am to 5pm.

During FOOD Week 2014 we will offer a French style Pique-Nique showcasing local cheese and produce accompanied by a glass of award winning wine. On Saturday, April 5 local band Fox and Friends will entertain guests as they enjoy their food and wine in the glorious surroundings at Hedberg Hill.
