Located in the heart of a dynamic food and cool-climate wine region, Millthorpe is a centre for truffle production and is also home to a vibrant community of local artists, and has a diverse range of talented people living and working in the village.

Established in the pioneering era, Millthorpe has a rich agricultural history, a legacy of grand buildings, heritage architecture and a streetscape that has remained largely unchanged since the early 1900s, in fact, the entire village is classified by the National Trust.

Food and wine

Located at the heart of a dynamic food and cool-climate wine region, Millthorpe has a variety of eateries to suit all tastes and budgets, from cafes, pubs and bistros through to award-winning restaurants, providing delicious meals using fresh local produce accompanied by delicious Orange region wines.

The village is also home to several charming cellar doors, selling a diverse range of locally-produced cool-climate wines.

Boutique shops, art and antiques

Millthorpe has an eclectic mix of interesting boutique, art and antique shops. The village centre comes alive on weekends with locals and tourists all enjoying the unique range of shopping, art and antiques on offer.

Millthorpe is a haven for curio hunters, culture buffs and those in need of some unique retail therapy, with everything from homewares and furniture, clothing, shoes, jewellery and books to lollies, plants, patchwork, toys and gifts.

Tours

Enjoy a self-guided walking tour of Millthorpe, choosing between the two-kilometre railway walk or the three-kilometre village/country walk. Starting at the post office, the railway walk enjoys views over most of the village, before heading across the railway bridge and down Glenorie Road to see the station from the railway side.

Heading back into town via the railway underpass, the walk takes in Victoria Street and Mill Green, going past the Grand Western Lodge and Pym Street shops before heading up the slope to the old Bank of NSW (now Rosebank) and back to the post office.

Also starting at the post office, the village/country walk passes the public school, museum and fire station, Redmond Oval, churches and cemetery. See John Lister's grave and enjoy views to Mount Canobolas before heading around the north-western corner of the village to the Great Western Mill site by the railway line.

The walk then leads you up Victoria Street to the Grand Western Lodge and Pym Street shops, before heading back to beautiful Rosebank and the post office starting point. Download the village walks brochure at www.millthorpevillage.com.au.
