## Golden Memories Museum

Take a step back through time and see heritage come to life at the Golden Memories Museum. There are historic buildings, fascinating history with memories of pioneering days, gold discovery and mining displays, and a huge collection of farm machinery.

The Good Templars Hall houses many treasures - Victorian and Edwardian pieces as well as a pistol and fossicking pick which belonged to John Lister.

Plus there's a unique display of Wiradjuri weapons and objects from the district.

In the Cadia Theatrette a collection of gold mining and geology supports video of the current gold mining operation at Cadia Valley Operations.

The museum is at 37-39 Park Street and is open from 10am weekends, school and public holidays, excluding Good Friday and Christmas Day.
