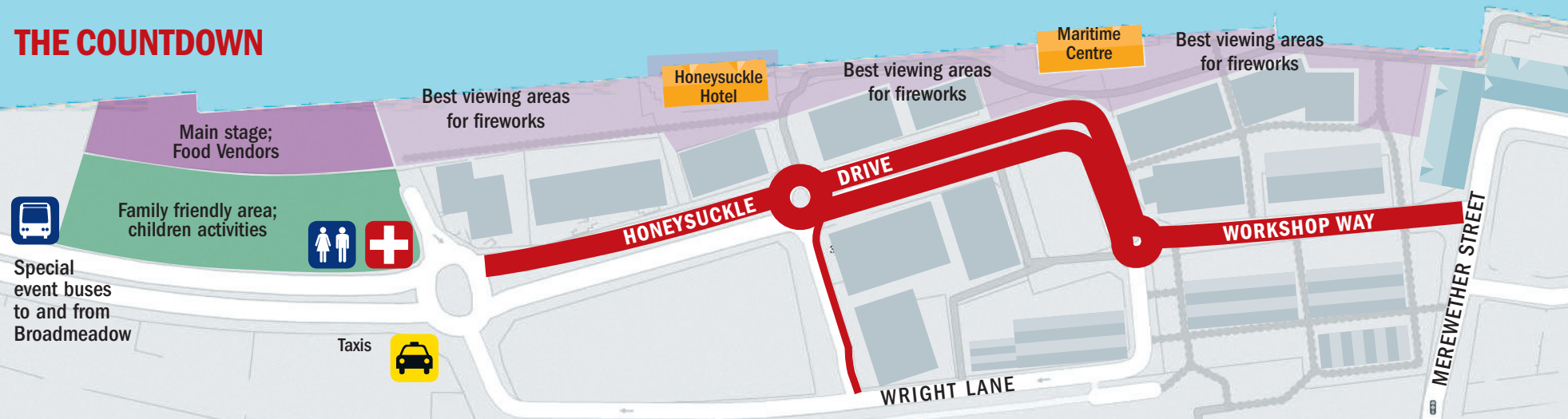


THE COUNTDOWN

STOCKTON FORESHORE

- Stockton is a popular spot to watch the 9pm fireworks
- Parking is permitted on the Ballast Ground from 9am on New Year's Eve
- Camping (including tents) is not permitted

ROAD CLOSURES

- From 6pm-10pm
- Honeysuckle Drive, between Wright Lane and Settlement Lane (eastbound)

- Honeysuckle Drive, between Settlement Lane and Workshop Way (both directions)
- Settlement Lane, between Honeysuckle Drive and Wright Lane (southbound)
- Workshop Way, between Honeysuckle Drive and Merewether Street
- Wharf Road, between Watt Street and Horseshoe Bend Road

TRAIN

- The closest station to the Newcastle Foreshore is Broadmeadow on the Central Coast & Newcastle Line

- Change at Broadmeadow for a free special event shuttle bus towards Honeysuckle
- Extra train services will run on the Hunter Line to Broadmeadow every 15-30 minutes from 5.13pm to 12.15am
- Hunter Line services will depart Broadmeadow every 15-30 minutes between 6.39pm and midnight, and then every hour until 3.08am on New Year's Day
- If you're heading to the New Year's Eve celebrations from Newcastle, trains will not operate

between Newcastle and Broadmeadow stations

BUS

- A free shuttle bus service will run on New Year's Eve between Brown Street at Broadmeadow Station and Hannell Street on the Honeysuckle side of Wickham Station
- Buses towards Wickham will run between 5pm and 10.45pm with services back to Broadmeadow operating between 9.15pm and 11pm
- Newcastle Buses services are running to a public holiday timetable

TAXI

- A managed taxi rank will operate in Wharf Road opposite Scratchley's Restaurant

FERRY

- Newcastle Ferries services are running to a public holiday timetable
- Ferry services are limited and are likely to reach capacity so consider the alternate public transport options available
