Judging has been completed for the Dungog District Chamber of Commerce business awards with presentation night to be held on Saturday.

The awards are one way residents and fellow business owners of the district can show their appreciation and thanks for all the hard work and effort business owners and their staff put into their business.

Chamber president Jenny Lewis (pictured above) was pleased for the early response of nominations.

"People started getting their entries in early which was really pleasing," Ms Lewis said.

"This was the first year entries could be done online and this was popular with around 80 coming in that format."

People were able to nominate as many businesses or people as they wished and information on the form was used initially to shortlist finalists.

Winners were not found by the number of entries received, but were judged by site visits where possible to interview finalists.

Ms Lewis said by supporting these business awards you help to raise awareness of the contribution local business bring to our community.

"And we can reward those who have provided us with great service through the year," Ms Lewis said.

"Size doesn't matter, it's attitude,

quality and ability to promote our district that counts."

Categories include: Tourism and hospitality; rural producers, manufacturing and industry; professional services; trades; outstanding employee under 25 years and over 25 years; retail; customer service; Golden Axe (positive environmental impact); outstanding new business and business leader of the year.

"There were two new categories this year," Ms Lewis said.

"Outstanding employee over 25 years and business leader of the year recognises the positive contribution made to business by business people and professionals aged 35 years and over."

"The award recognises those who demonstrate outstanding entrepreneurial spirit, strategic business direction and innovative ideas, while providing inspiration to a new generation of upcoming business leaders."
