- Spectators are encouraged to use public transport to get to South Bank. TransLink services will operate to a limited timetable and transport schedules may be impacted—please check TransLink for timetables.
 - Russell Street will be closed for vehicle access from 6 am until 5 pm between Grey Street and the Cultural Forecourt.
 - Grey Street will be closed for vehicle access from 1 pm until 5 pm between Glenelg and Peel streets.
 - Little Stanley Street will be closed for vehicle access between Ernest and Tribune streets from 9 am until 2 pm.
 - Car parking will be accessible at the Brisbane Convention and Exhibition Centre, Queensland Performing Arts Centre, Gallery of Modern Art and State Library of Queensland.
 - Pedestrians will be able to enter the viewing positions along Russell Street from the Cultural Forecourt.
 - Limited access to the Playhouse Green will be available from Grey Street prior to the road closure.
 - Pedestrian access to Grey Street will be restricted during the day, with no access between Glenelg and Russell streets from 1 pm until 5 pm.
 - Spectators are reminded to be sun safe and wear sunscreen, hat, protective clothing and to bring plenty of water.
 - Bringing umbrellas, chairs, picnic blankets and pets is discouraged.
