

Celebrating 30 years Stephen O'Hara takes a step back in time

FOR 30 years Moree Retravision (now Leading Appliances) has served the Moree shire.

Owner Stephen O'Hara took over the role when his father Geoff passed away in 1998 and has seen the store move from the Criterion Centre to its current location on Balo Street.

He had previously spent time in Dubbo and felt he didn't "want to see the business go", he said.

Before Retravision, the company traded under the name of Betta Electrical Buying Group which they traded under until 1990.

A shop next door in the Criterion Centre closed down in 2000 and the ambitious crew at Retravision then expanded into the store.

"We were fairly crammed into the old shop," Mr O'Hara said at the time.

He said the new location in Balo Street had allowed them to become more competitive and was twice the size of the old store.

"We've got that frontage onto the main street instead of being in an arcade.

"Within the shop itself we can now display things a lot better than they previously were."

One of the many benefits of the store has been the minimal turnover of staff with many of the current members being around the company for a long time.

Margaret Hobday, Janice Cook, Stephen O'Hara, lan Patterson, Dave Cunningham, James Cubis and Brent Kendall stood out the front of the new building in 2008 after moving from the Criterion Centre. Margaret, Janice, Stephen and Dave are all current staff at Leading Appliances.
