#### SHAWN RICHARD Capital Trio founding director

Convicted on four criminal charges and serves two and a half years jail. Permanent ASIC ban from providing any financial services.

## DAVID MILHOUSE Trio founding director

APRA ban for 10 years to not be or act as a trustee of a registrable superannuation entity or a responsible office of any body corporate that is a trustee, investment manager or custodian of a registrable superannuation entity. No action taken by ASIC.

### REX PHILLPOTT

Former Trio Capital director and CEO ASIC ban for 15 years from providing financial services and taking park in the management of any corporation. APRA ban for 15 years from acting as a trustee of a registerable superannuation entity or a responsible officer of a body corporate that is a trustee, investment manager or custodian of a registerable superannuation entity.
